

Qualifications of Sojourner Student Missionaries North American Mission Board

Sojourner Summer Missionaries are high school students who serve for 4-10 weeks with local churches and North American Mission Board missionaries between May and August. They serve in teams of 2 to 20 students in evangelism and church planting projects across the United States and Canada. Round-trip transportation, health and accident insurance, food and housing and quality supervision are provided.

The basic qualifications for students to apply are:

- **Committed Christian who is actively following Jesus Christ**
- **Personal and emotional maturity**
- **Minimum 2.0 grade point average**
- **Completed Junior year of high school**
- **Active member of a Southern Baptist Church**
- **Sense of God's leadership to serve**
